

THEY (the couple)

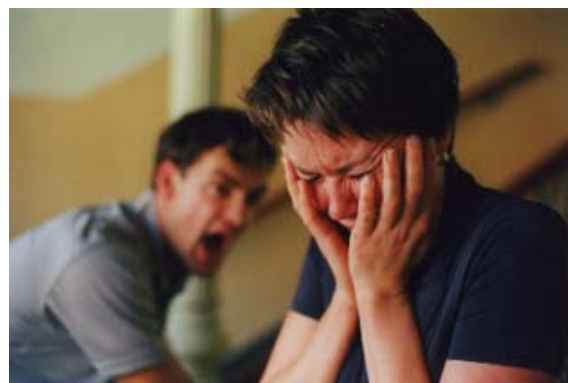
They have been together for 10 years. Married 6 years. Met when they were young and unformed. At the moment their financial situation is shaky, due to her education.



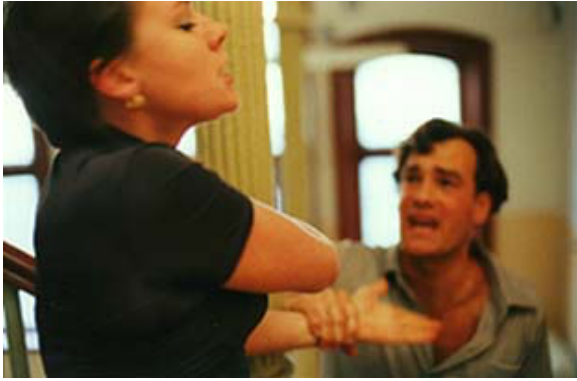
